**CALL TO ORDER**

Mayor Eskridge called the Special City Council meeting to order at 4:45 P.M. Councilmember LJ Williams gave the invocation. Mayor Eskridge led the audience in the pledge of allegiance. Council roll call indicated a quorum of council members present for the meeting.

**BUSINESS:**

**A. EMERGENCY ONE LEASE – FIRE TRUCK**

Mayor Eskridge stated that the City had negotiated a lease that was not approved by Council.

Councilmember Weaver made a motion to approve the lease. Councilmember DeLoughy seconded the motion. Council Members discussed the terms of the lease, payment schedule and Cumberland Harbour's obligation. The City Attorney recommended

written documents from Cumberland Harbour with a fixed payment schedule. He also recommended that the City provide written notice to Emergency One to address Article IX, Option to Purchase, of the lease for the purchase of the equipment. Following much discussion, voting was unanimous in favor of the motion.
